We would like to officially invite you to participate in The Days of '47 All Horse Parade. The Parade will be held on Saturday, **July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010 at 10 a.m.** The venue for this year's Parade will be the same as last year, the Sandy South Towne Center. As you know, this venue provides better security, seating, crowd control and protection, as well as an expanded route and, hopefully, a larger viewing audience. **Registration:** The enclosed entry form must be completely filled out and returned before June 10, 2010. A parade information packet will be sent to the leader of each registered Parade group or individual entrant by July 1<sup>st</sup>.

As we continue to expand the size of the Parade and the number of participants each year, we ask that you spread the word to any and all that might be interested in participating. **\*Adult riders or adults on foot are encouraged to accompany youth groups to ensure safety.**

**Awards:** The winners of the Parade categories will be called ASAP after the All Horse Parade. The results will also be printed in the *Salt Lake Tribune* and the *Deseret News*. The prize money will be mailed to the contact person listed on your application, in the

name of the organization or individual. Please be sure you have a valid organization named so that your check can be cashed.

**Judging:** Categories will be judged on (1) Cleanliness and grooming of horses; (2) Presentation; (3) Attire; and (4) Parking and staging etiquette. Judging criteria will be similar to the criteria used for The Days of '47 KSL 5 Parade.

**Parade Route:** The Parade route begins at the intersection of 10000 South and 240 West in Sandy, going east ½ block to the west side lane of Centennial Parkway. The route continues south on the Parkway looping around at the end and turning north up the east side and returning to 10000 South. The route then turns east ½ block to Civic Center Drive, then north on Civic around Sandy City Hall to return to the starting and lineup point. Staging of individuals/groups and wagons/carriages will be near the Parade starting point. A map of the Parade route and staging area can be viewed at The Days of '47 website.

**Parking:** The information packet will specify parking area assignments, instructions for staging and precautions/instructions for the Parade. Please be respectful of the property and leave all the premises clean.

**Parade Participant Order:** Assigned Parade positions and numbers will be available for pickup at the Check-In booth starting at 8:30 a.m. on Parade day, July 10<sup>th</sup>. Along with the description of your entry, this will allow the announcers located at various positions along the route to properly introduce each entry. Participants need to be ready to be staged for the Parade by 9:30 a.m. Please be prompt.

The All Horse Parade is a great tradition and helps the community remember the heritage we have with these fine animals. We truly appreciate your interest and support. We wish you success and look forward to working with you on Saturday, July 10, 2010. If you have questions or need additional information, please feel free to call.
