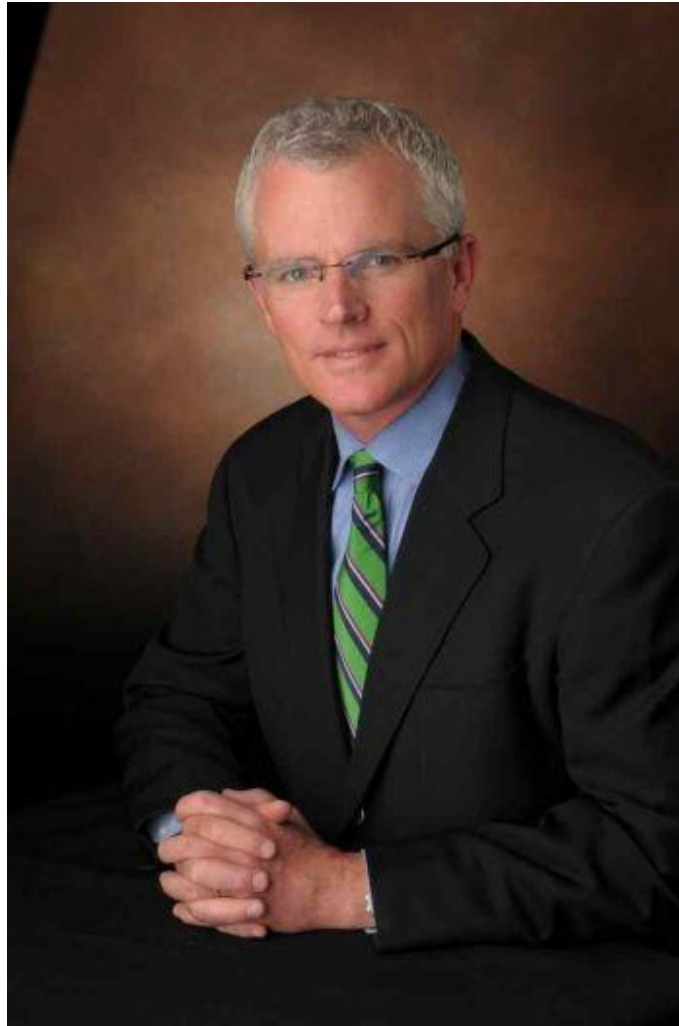

Healing Hands for Haiti

In 1998, Dr. Randle helped found the Healing Hands for Haiti International Foundation (HHHI), established to support rehabilitation of Haiti's disabled adults and children. Along with the help of volunteer teams across the US and Canada, the Foundation has supported the treatment of over 25,000 patients, provided more than 1,000 prosthetic limbs, supported 45 orphanages with disabled children and trained over 100 clinicians in rehabilitation medicine. The January earthquake in Haiti destroyed all but one of the HHHI clinic buildings. Dr. Randle and his teams worked tirelessly to re-open the remaining clinic and have provided emergency and rehabilitative care to hundreds of earthquake victims. Dr. Randle continues his medical practice in Salt Lake City, Utah as he works to raise awareness and funding for a new HHHI rehabilitation hospital now needed to serve an additional 40,000 Haitians facing physical disability in the earthquake's aftermath.
