

# The Days of '47 Youth Parade 2010

## "Pioneer Spirit - Then and Now"

### July 17, 2010

#### Day of Parade Information

- 1. PARADE ROUTE:** The parade will begin at 500 South and 600 East, Salt Lake City. The parade will proceed west along 500 South and disperse at the City/County building at 200 East and 500 South.
- 2. FLOAT TRAVEL AND ARRIVAL:** Salt Lake City Police suggest floats travel to the parade via 700 East or State Street, rather than using the freeway. It may be helpful to bring a staple gun or duct tape with you to repair any damages incurred during travel.
- 3. LINE UP DIRECTIONS:** Information about entry line up and parade position will be provided in July, 2010. This will help you see which direction your entry will enter the line up area on surrounding 500 South. Please note the Youth Parade route map at [www.daysof47.com](http://www.daysof47.com).
- 4. CHECK IN:** Check in begins at 8:00 a.m. One person from each entry must visit the Information Booth at the corner of 500 South and 600 East to register and receive instructions. A packet containing thank you certificates for the entire group will be exchanged for the entry's Photography Releases. All participants in your entry must sign a Photography Release (or a parent/guardian must sign on behalf of each child) that will be delivered by your representative when registering at the Information Booth on the morning of the parade.
- 5. PARTICIPANT ARRIVAL:** Participants in your entry (and float, if applicable) should arrive no later than 8:30 a.m. Participants need to know their organization or LDS Stake name to obtain directions or assistance. Parade volunteers will help direct children to their lineup spot. It is recommended that each entry bring water and sunscreen for all participants.
- 6. MARCHING:** A parade volunteer will direct you when it is time for your entry to enter the parade route and begin marching. Please be prepared move as our volunteers instruct and be alert to changes in position beginning at 10 a.m. There must be 1 adult marching for every 10 children participating.
- 7. END OF PARADE:** Enter the grassy area of the City/County building at 200 East and 500 South. Please situate your children in a group and wait with them while parents or adult guardians arrive to collect their children. **PLEASE DO NOT LEAVE CHILDREN UNATTENDED.**
- 8. YOUTH FESTIVAL:** A Youth Festival will be held on the grounds of the City/County building immediately following the parade and will continue until Noon. This **free event** is intended as a thank you for the participants in the Youth Parade and is open to the public. Attractions, entertainment and hands-on learning activities will be provided. Parents or youth leaders should supervise all children while attending the Youth Festival. Food will be available for purchase.
